

GENERAL RULES

1. **\$125.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Grand Champion** Pecan entry. **\$75.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Reserve champion entry**, and ribbons will be awarded in each variety division.
2. Pecans must be from exhibitor's 2010 crop.
3. Entries will be accepted from Pecos County State Bank only.
4. Each entry must consist of 40 pecans of the same variety.
5. Pecans will be exhibited in their natural state. Do not polish or attempt to alter color or shape.
6. Pecans will be shown and judged by variety.
7. *Entries will be accepted until 9:00 a.m. December 2nd. It is preferred that all entries be brought to the County Extension Office by December 1st.*
8. All pecans become the property of the Pecos County Pecan Growers Assn.
9. Pecan entries will be exhibited for public viewing at 1:00 p.m. on December 2nd.

GENERAL RULES

1. **\$125.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Grand Champion food entries in both the Adult and Youth Divisions.** **\$75.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Reserve Champion entries in both Adult and Youth Divisions**, and ribbons will be awarded in each division.
2. Pecans must be an ingredient in the recipe.
3. The entire recipe must be entered for judging. In the "Cookies" and "Candy" divisions, please enter a sample of two dozen.
4. All food, when entered, becomes the property of the Food Show.
5. Place food on disposable dishes, cover with plastic wrap, and place your name on the bottom of the container.
6. **2 copies of the recipe must be submitted with each entry on 8½ x 11 sheet of paper. The division must be stated on recipe.**
7. There will be no limit on the number of entries per person.
8. Food entries must be at the Pecos County State Bank of Fort Stockton by 9:30 a.m. on December 2nd, or you may bring entries to the County Extension Office on Dec 1st. Judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. on December 2nd.
9. The Food Show will be open to the public at 1:00 p.m. on December 2nd.
