- 2. Pecans must be from exhibitor's 2010 crop.
- 3. Entries will be accepted from Pecos County State Bank only.
- 4. Each entry must consist of 40 pecans of the same variety.
- 5. Pecans will be exhibited in their natural state. Do not polish or attempt to alter color or shape.
- 6. Pecans will be shown and judged by variety.
- 7. Entries will be accepted until 9:00 a.m. December 2<sup>nd</sup>. It is preferred that all entries be brought to the County Extension Office by December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 8. All pecans become the property of the Pecos County Pecan Growers Assn.
- 9. Pecan entries will be exhibited for public viewing at 1:00 p.m. on December 2<sup>nd</sup>.
